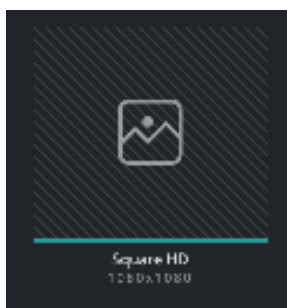
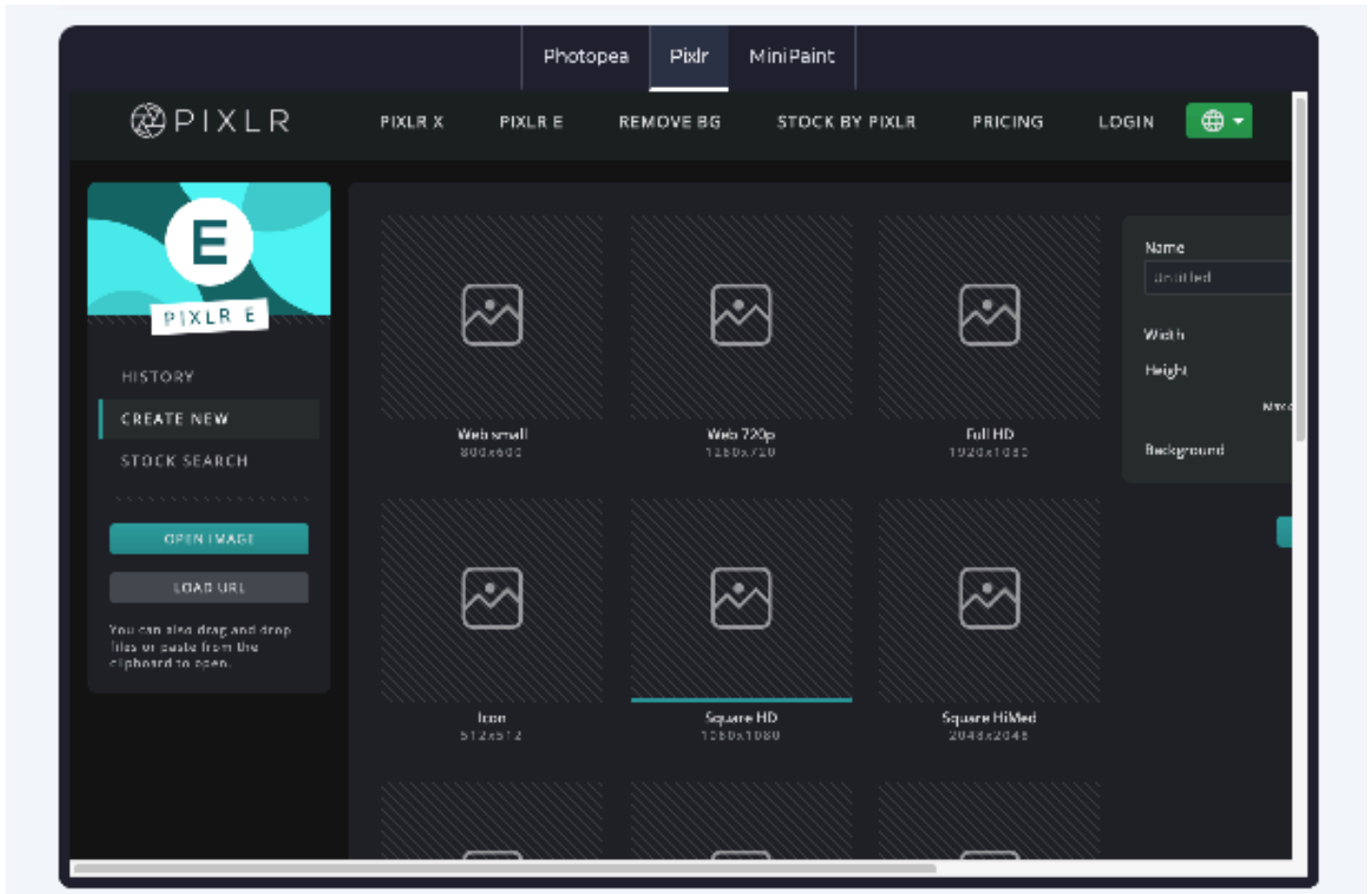


Using Pixlr to overlay Instagram frame over image

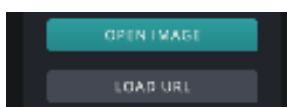
step 1

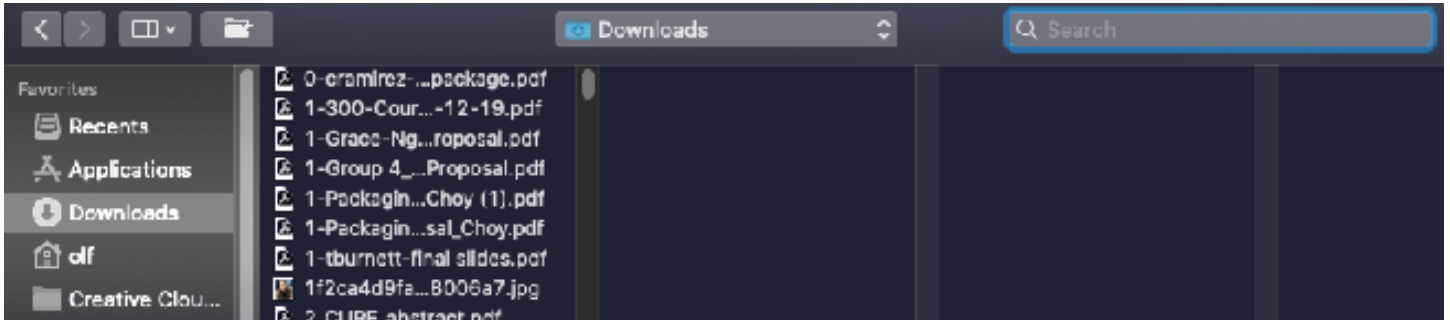


Select SQUARE HD for instagram post

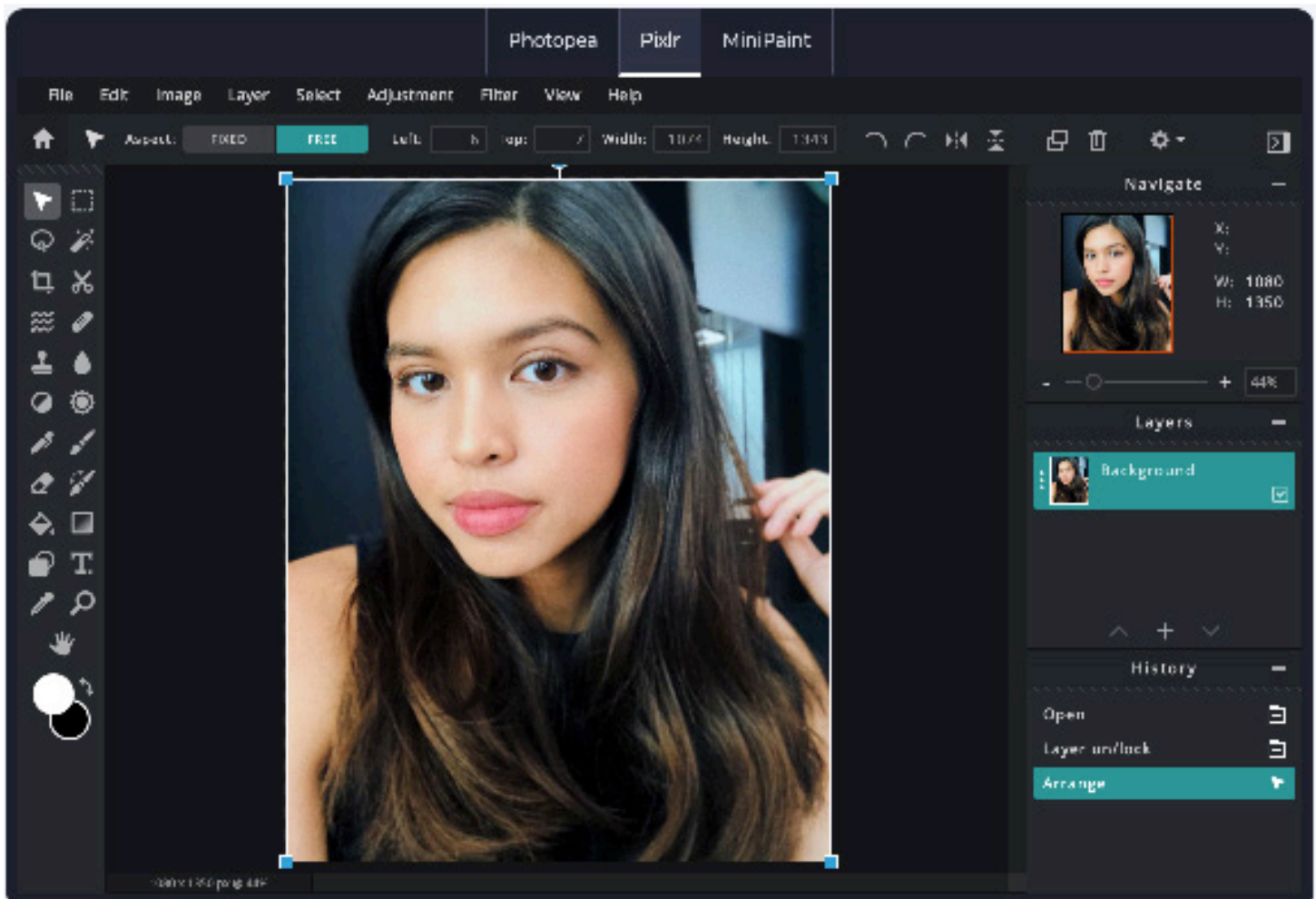


then click OPEN IMAGE

step 2

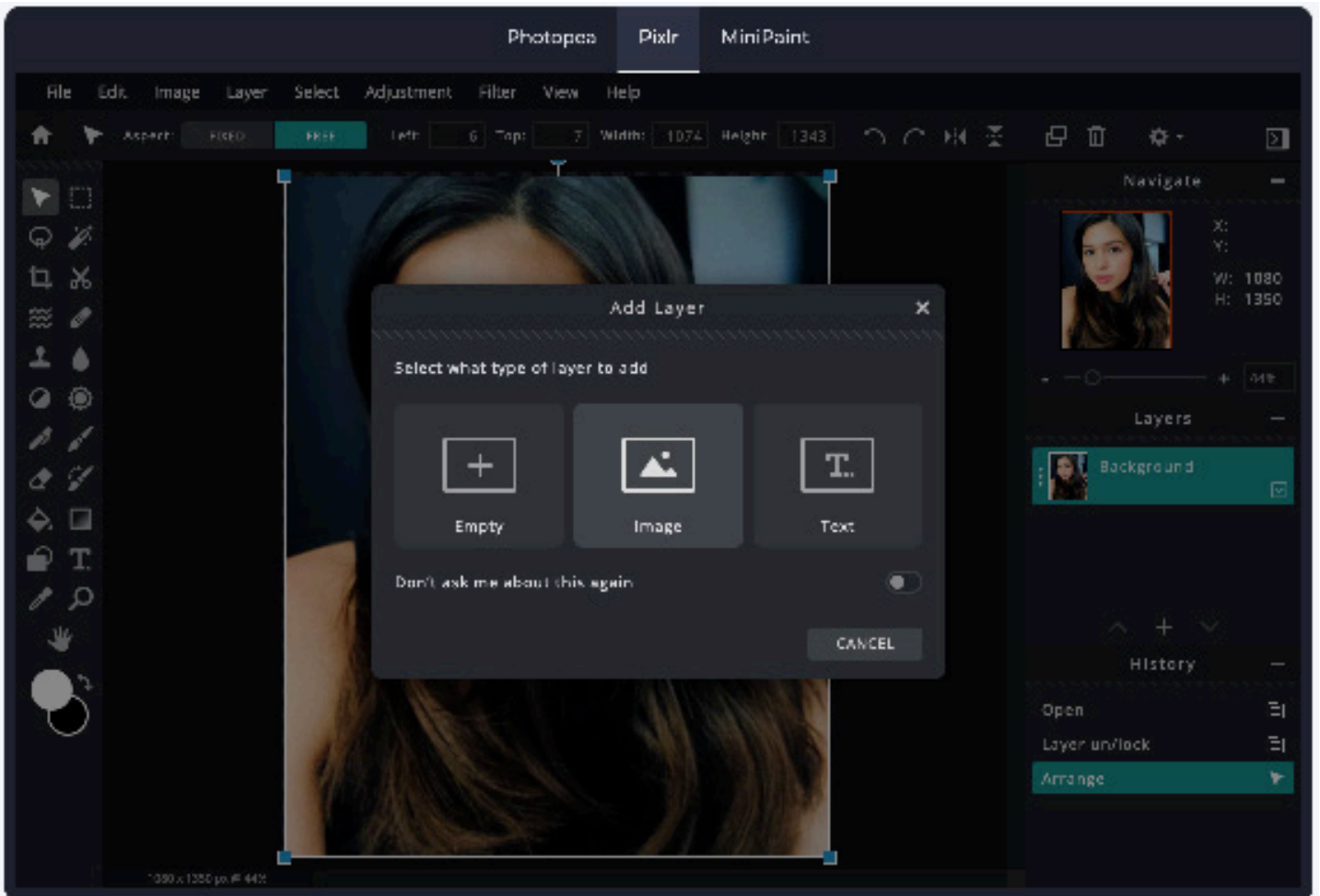



choose image you wish to edit (.jpg)

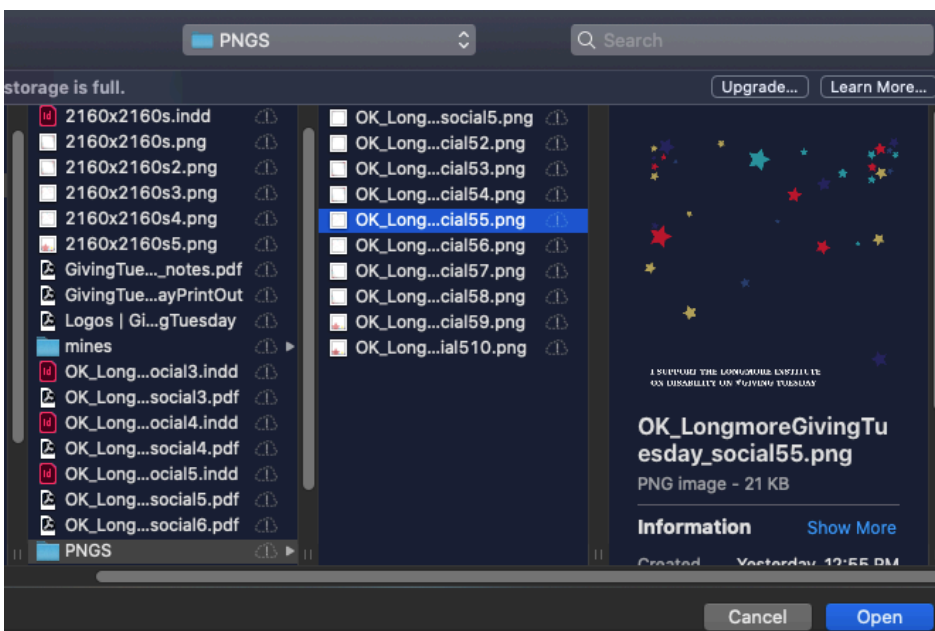


background layer is now the image

step 3



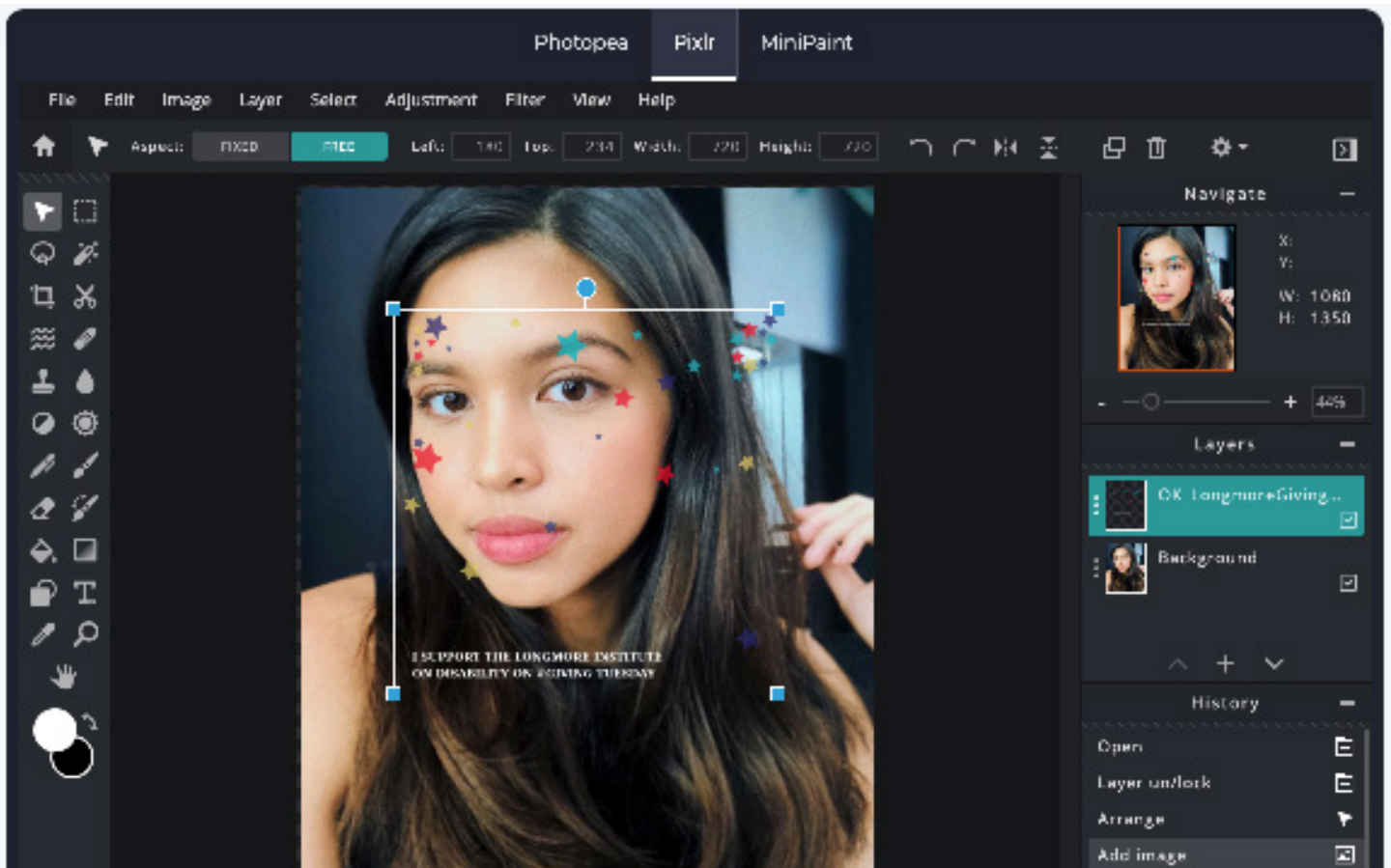
on your layers panel there is a  click on that to add an image



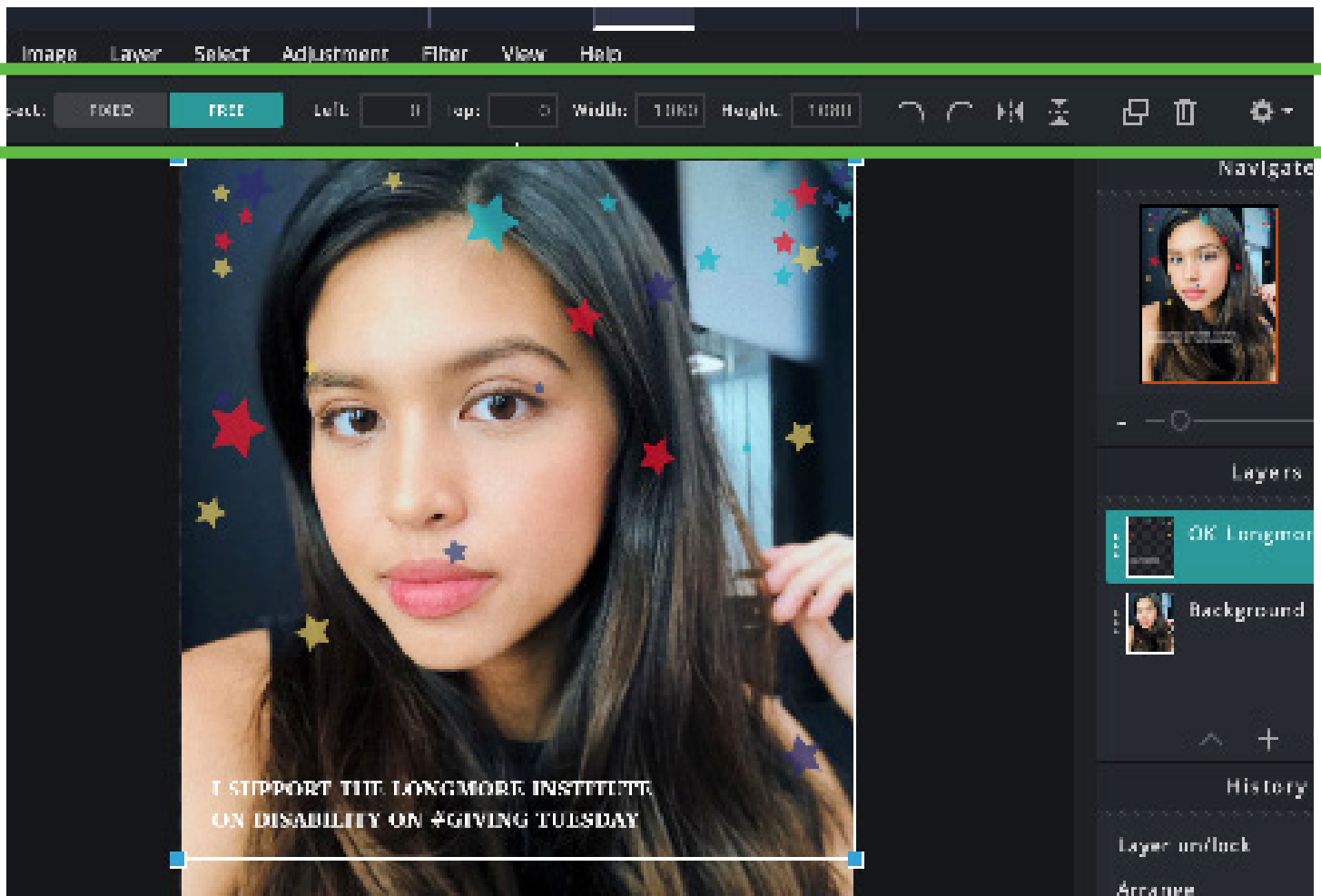
select the **.png** frame you wish to apply

Then click OPEN to add as the new layer

step 4



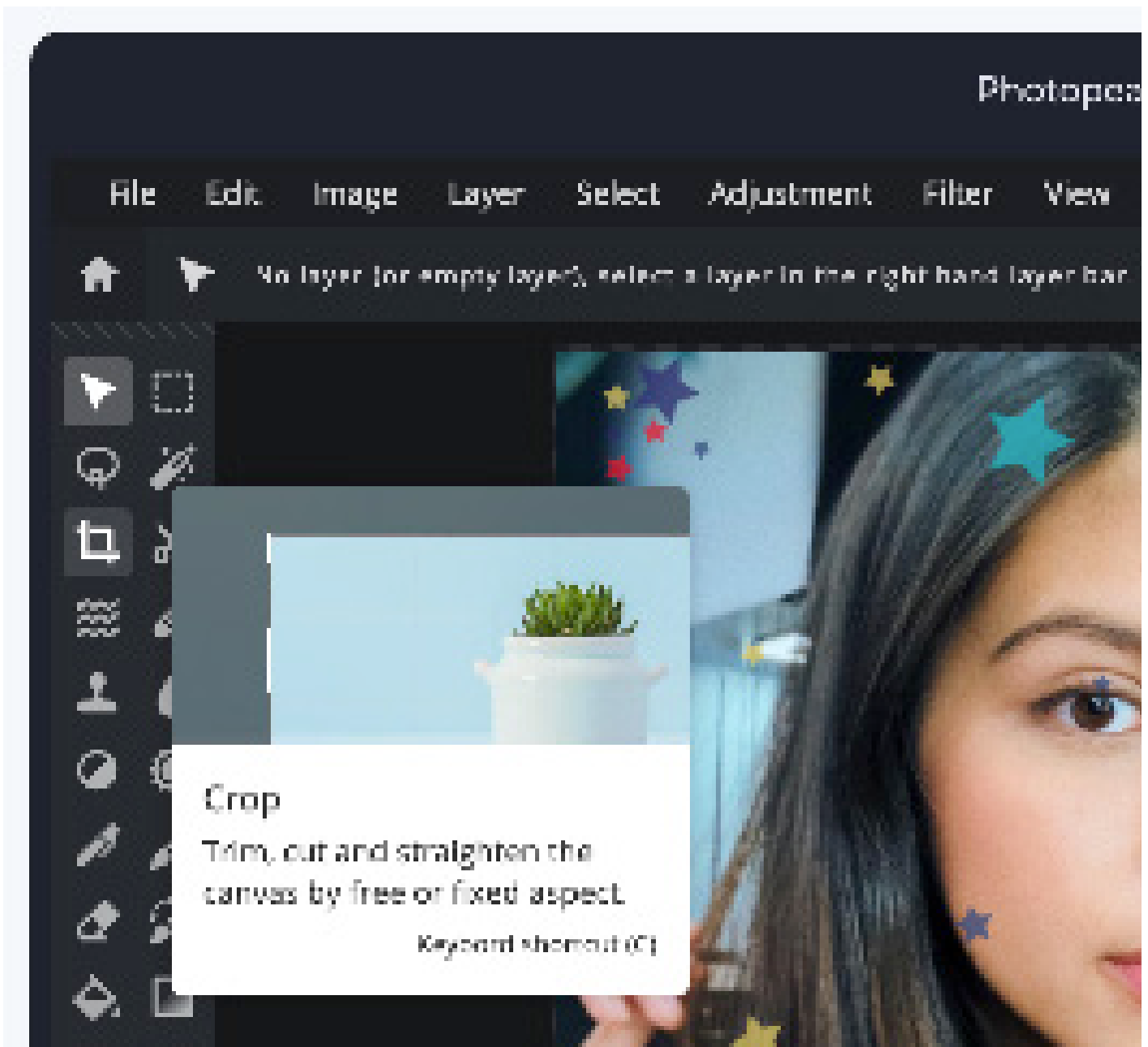
You can now adjust the frame to the image
By clicking on the blue pins, you can scale the new layer to a 1080 x 1080 square format for Instagram



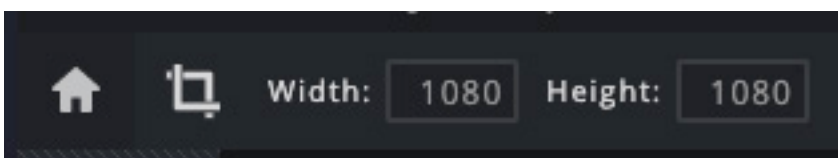
A quick way to do this is to go to the top tool bar where it shows the width and height

make sure FREE is selected as the aspect

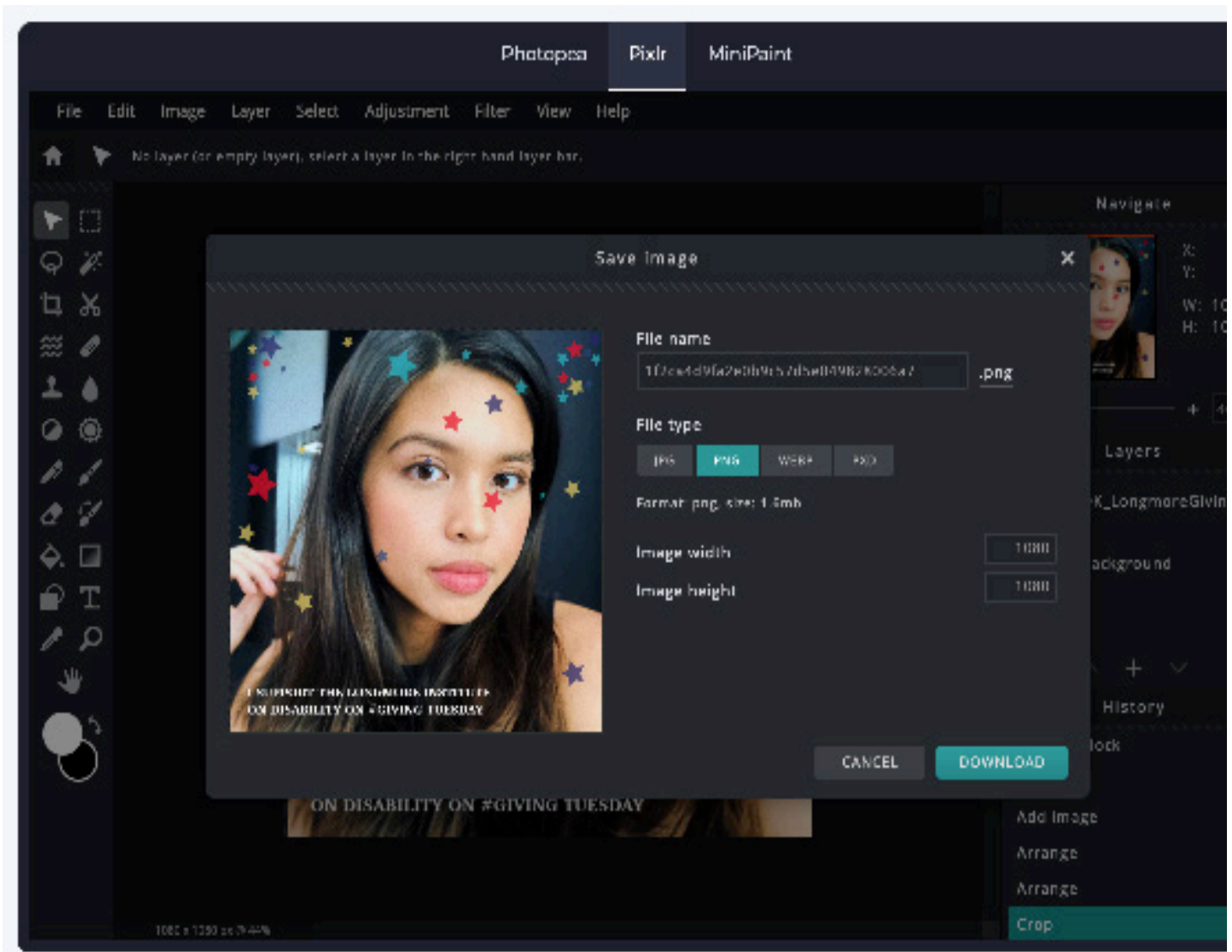
and manually type in 1080 for the Width & Height



To insure the image stays 1080 x 1080 (square format)
Select your BACKGROUND LAYER
so you can crop your image in the **background layer**



You can manually type this in as well



Click on FILE as the top left corner

Select SAVE

choose desired file type

(.jpg .png or .pdf)

Then click DOWNLOAD
